Amid uncertainty in the ag economy, as many producers face tightening margins and production expenses projected to reach record highs this year, the Center for Agricultural Profitability (CAP) has led statewide educational efforts to help producers understand their finances and cost of production to strengthen their decision-making in a volatile environment. Our Agricultural Budget Calculator program (ABC), now with over 2,000 users, gives farmers and ranchers a clear view of their numbers, allowing them to customize budgets, test scenarios and confidently pin down their cost of production.
