Nebraska Extension has a positive financial impact on millions of acres of farm and ranch land, helping ensure the sustainability of Nebraska agriculture by making it more profitable.

- Hundreds of users logged on to the Agricultural Budget Calculator program, developed by the Center, to more effectively track cost of production and other essential business items.
- Relunched the Returning to the Farm program for families in the transition process of bringing new family members back to the operation.
- Collaborated with the Rural & Farm Finance Policy Analysis Center at the University of Missouri on the first in a series of semi-annual publications on farm income in Nebraska.
- Hundreds of prospective land seekers and retiring landowners applied to the Nebraska Land Link program to be matched.
